Dear Families,

As we get closer to opening our Center, as Covid cases continue to decline in Gloucester County, we are reaching out to update you on our visitation process. We are now doing visits, indoors for the morning sessions. Visits will be in our lounge area off the patio. We are strongly encouraging any one entering the building to be swabbed/tested. We have been Covid free 9 months and are taking every precaution to continue this status. Best practices known to stay that way are temperature, testing and mask.

If your loved one has been vaccinated, the visit will be a little more liberal ie: no longer 6 ft apart, hand holding after sanitized and hugs are allowed! All must still wear a surgical mask throughout the entire visit. Please note it must be a surgical mask, no scarfs, material masks w filters etc. will be allowed.

We will also be increasing our amount of outdoor visitation to 4 families, social distanced, at one time on the patio. The schedule will still be Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. As we continue moving forward this too will be expanded. We are taking small steps to ensure the safety and health of your loved ones here at Deptford Center.

Please call the front desk to check availability, for indoor and patio visits. We have over 200 Residents and we are attempting to ensure everyone has a chance to visit their loved one. We are also offerings compassionate care visits for certain circumstances. Please call your unit manager for specifics.
